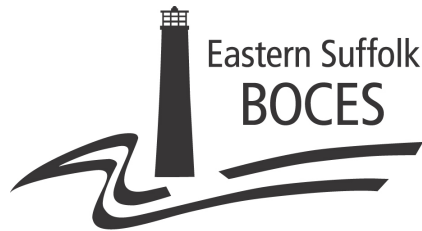

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## **DR. EDWARD J. MILLIKEN LIGHTHOUSE SCHOLARSHIP**

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The *Edward J. Milliken Lighthouse Scholarship* was established and endowed on the occasion of Dr. Milliken's retirement from public education in June 1998. Over the past 22 years, more than \$60,000 has been distributed to Eastern Suffolk BOCES students to further their education.

The *Edward J. Milliken Lighthouse Scholarship* is awarded annually to high school graduates who have completed Eastern Suffolk BOCES programs and have enrolled in institutions of higher education.

Criteria for eligibility include:

- Graduation from a high school within the Eastern Suffolk BOCES services area;
- Successful completion of an Eastern Suffolk BOCES program of study;
- Letters of recommendation from an Eastern Suffolk BOCES teacher and Principal, as well as from the student's school district guidance counselor; and
- Confirmation that the student will pursue an educational program at an institution of higher education.

Following a review of applications, the Board of Directors of the Edward J. Milliken Lighthouse Scholarship Committee will determine the recipients of the Scholarship.
